Born on April 2, 1929 at the family farm known as "Bloomfield" near Dranesville, Fairfax County Virginia, the area was saturated with history. With the surrounding woods & fields being occupied repeatedly by both the Confederate & Union forces, Dick was naturally exposed to the history of the Civil War at an early age. With encouragement from his older brother Frank Jr., Dick started to search the nearby fields for Civil War relics. In 1954, he acquired a "Home Built" metal detector, his first, and shortly afterwards, Him, his brother & a friend searched the nearby Balls Bluff Battlefield on the Potomac River north of Leesburg, VA. Shortly after arriving, he had his reading & dug a US belt buckle. From that point on, he was hooked and spent the next several decades developing his passion of relic hunting with friends & his son Paul wherever he could with his primary hunting areas being the Northern VA & Upper Potomac River areas. Dick became one of the founding members of the Northern Virginia Relic Hunter's Association that is recognized as the leading Civil War collecting association in the country. This weekend, we present to you the fruits of his endeavors and can only hope you too will enjoy adding his finds to your collection as much as Dick enjoyed hunting and having them.
